

SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

BETHLEHEM COLLEGE, TAURANGA

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 19th day of September two thousand and seventeen (2017) BETWEEN **BETHLEHEM COLLEGE LTD** ("the Proprietor") of the first part and **HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN** acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister") of the second part.

WHEREAS

- A** By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 16th September 1999 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established **Bethlehem College, Tauranga** as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- B** The Proprietor and the Minister wish to vary the Deed of Agreement to replace the Plan attached to the Second Schedule with a new Plan pursuant to section 423(3) of the Education Act 1989.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT** the words "One thousand six hundred and ten (1610) pupils" in line 4 of Clause 16 of the deed of Agreement be deleted and the words "One thousand seven hundred and ninety (1790) pupils, consisting of 120 places at Y1-Y8 at the Rotorua campus and 60 places over two years, 30 places in 2018 and 30 places in 2019, at Y9-Y13 at the Tauranga campus" be substituted therefor.
- 2. THAT** the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
