THIS DEED is made this 14th day of acto be 1997

BETWEEN THE OTAGO PRESBYTERIAN GIRLS' COLLEGE BOARD OF GOVERNORS (hereinafter together with its successors called "the Proprietor") a body registered pursuant to the Incorporated Societies Act 1908 of the one part

AND HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter called "the Minister") of the other part

BACKGROUND

- A. The parties to this agreement are parties to an agreement for the integration of Columba College pursuant to the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 which agreement is dated the 28th day of January 1994 and has been amended by a deed dated 16th January 1996 ("the agreement").
- B. The parties wish to amend the agreement.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH:

- Clause 19 of the agreement dated 28th January 1994 as substituted by the agreement dated 16th January 1996 shall no longer apply and the following is adopted in its place:
 - "19. It is agreed by the parties hereto that the maximum School roll shall be 550 pupils with 120 in the new entrants to Standard 4 area and 430 in the Form 1 to 7 area, unless and until otherwise agreed by the Proprietor and the Minister and the parties hereto enter into a supplementary agreement to give effect thereto."
