this deed of agreement is made on the 27th day of Anticst One thousand nine hundred and eighty six (1986)

OF AUCKLAND a "Corporation Sole" (hereinafter with his successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") of the second part WHEREAS

- A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 30th day of March 1983 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established St. Joseph's School, Waitaruke as an integrated school.
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend Clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

1 THAT the words "twenty-three (23)"

in the 4th line in Clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement be deleted from that Agreement and the words "Thirty (30)"

be substituted therefor.
