## SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

## HOLY CROSS SCHOOL, MIRAMAR

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the May of October One thousand nine hundred and ninety seven (1997) BETWEEN THE ROMAN CATHOLIC ARCHBISHOP OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF WELLINGTON a Corporation Sole (hereinafter referred to as "the Proprietor") and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister").

## WHEREAS

- A Following a Deed of Agreement dated the 1<sup>st</sup> day of March 1983 as varied by subsequent agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), between the Minister and the Proprietor, the Minister pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") established Holy Cross School, Miramar as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- Pursuant to section 7(9) of the Act, the Proprietor and the Minister have agreed to change the number of non-preference pupils in attendance at the school as specified in clause 10 (b) of the Deed of Agreement.

## NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THE Deed of Agreement is hereby amended by omitting from clause 10 (b) the words "shall be limited at all times to five (5) per cent" and substituting the words "shall be limited at all times to ten (10) per cent".
- 2. THAT the covenants, conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Deed of Agreement shall be read together with clause 1 of this Supplementary Deed of Agreement but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
