

SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

OUR LADY OF THE SNOWS SCHOOL, METHVEN

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 9th day of March
One thousand nine hundred and ninety-four (1994) BETWEEN
THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOP OF THE DIOCESE OF CHRISTCHURCH a
"Corporation Sole" (hereinafter with his successors
referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part and HER
MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of
Education (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister") of
the second part

WHEREAS

- A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 27th day of
January 1982 as varied by any subsequent
supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as
"the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the
Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private
Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established
Our Lady of the Snows School, Methven, as an
integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the
School").
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the
need to amend Clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement
pursuant to Section 7(9) of the Private Schools
Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY
COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES
HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the words "fifty-three (53)" in the 5th line in
Clause 8 of the original Deed of Agreement be deleted
from that Agreement and the words "sixty-six (66)" be
substituted therefor.
