

SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 15th day of December one thousand nine hundred and ninety-five (1995) **BETWEEN MARANATHA FOUNDATION**, a "charitable trust" (hereinafter with its successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part and **HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN** acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister") of the second part

WHEREAS

- A** By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 13th day of March 1995 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7 (2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established Maranatha Christian School, as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the school")
- B** The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend Clause 20 of the Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7 (9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** the words "that the maximum roll of the school shall be 140" in the third line of clause 20 of the Deed of Agreement be deleted from that Agreement and the words "that the maximum roll of the school shall be 160" be substituted therefor.

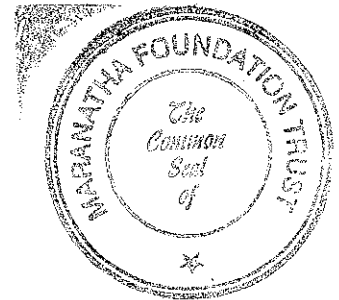
