SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the day of Jum One thousand nine hundred and ninety-two (1992) BETWEEN THE NEW ZEALAND MARIST BROTHERS TRUST BOARD a body corporate (hereinafter with its successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister") of the second part

- By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 30th day of Α March 1983 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established Marcellin College, Auckland, as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the В need to amend Recital B on page 1 and Clause 23 of the Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- THAT the words "for boys only" in line 3 of Recital B on page 1 be deleted from the Agreement.
- THAT the words "for boys only" in lines 3 and 4 of Clause 23 on page 11 of the Agreement be deleted.

3. THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
