SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

NEW PLYMOUTH SEVENTH-DAY ADVENTIST SCHOOL

This deed

is made on the 20th day of December 1996

between

The New Zealand Seventh-day Adventist Schools Association Limited being the proprietor of the New Plymouth Seventh-day Adventist School the said proprietor being a body duly incorporated under the Companies Act 1955 (hereinafter together with its successors and assigns called "the Proprietor") of the first part

and

Her Majesty the Queen acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter called "Minister") of the second part

whereas

- A. By Deed of Agreement bearing the date of 26 July 1993 (hereinafter referred to as "the original Deed of Agreement") as varied by a subsequent Supplementary Agreement bearing the date of 18 February 1994 (hereinafter together referred to as "the Integration Agreements), the Proprietor and the Minister pursuant to Sections 7(2) and 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 firstly established the New Plymouth Seventh-day Adventist School and then increased its maximum roll from 45 to 50.
- B. The Proprietors and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend clause 25 of the original Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7 (9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

Now this deed of agreement witnesseth that it is hereby covenanted agreed and declared by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. That clause 25 of the original Deed of Agreement shall be replaced by the following:

"For the purposes of Section 65(1)(c) the position of all teachers other than the Principal shall be positions of importance carrying a responsibility for religious instruction. Advertisements for these positions shall state that a willingness and ability to take part in

religious instruction appropriate to the Special Character of the School shall be an essential condition of appointment. Such advertisements shall also state that a willingness and ability to uphold the Special Character shall be a condition of appointment."

2. That the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Integration Agreements shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Integration Agreements are confirmed.
