AND WHEREAS the parties are now desirous of recording the said variation of roll numbers by way of this deed made pursuant to Section 7 (9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THE provisions of Clause 6 of the said Deed are hereby varied.
- 2. THE maximum school roll is hereby varied to 180 pupils which shall include a maximum of 13 day pupils.
- 3. THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the said Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
