BOARD at Marton (hereinafter together with its successors and assigns called "the Proprietor") of the first part AND HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter called "the Minister") of the second part

<u>WHEREAS</u> the Minister and the Proprietor have entered into a Deed dated the 15th day of December 1981 pursuant to which the Wellington Diocesan School for Girls (Nga Tawa) apart from its boarding establishment became an integrated Secondary School under the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975

<u>AND WHEREAS</u> Clause 6 of the said Deed stipulates maximum roll numbers in respect of the said School

<u>AND WHEREAS</u> the Proprietor has made application to the Minister to vary these roll numbers

<u>AND WHEREAS</u> the parties are now desirous of recording the said variation of roll numbers by way of this deed made pursuant to Section 7 (9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:

1. THE provisions of Clause 6 of the said Deed are hereby varied

2. THE maximum school roll is hereby varied to 240 pupils which shall include

a maximum of 25 day pupils

<u>3.</u> <u>THAT</u> the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the said Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
