BETWEEN TRINITY SCHOOLS TRUST BOARD a registered Charitable Trust (hereinafter together with its successors and assigns called "the Proprietor") of the one part

A N D HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter called "the Minister") of the other part

WHEREAS:

- A The Proprietor and the Minister are parties to a certain Deed of Agreement relating to the integration of Rathkeale College at Masterton, dated 4 May 1992 and entered into under the provisions of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 (hereinafter referred to as "the original Deed of Agreement")
- B The Proprietor and the Minister wish to enter into a variation of the original Deed of Agreement

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSES:


1. That the number "100" appearing in the third line of clause 20 of the original Deed of Agreement be deleted and the number "125" be inserted in its place.
