

SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

SACRED HEART SCHOOL, GUILFORD TERRACE, WELLINGTON

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 27 day of October

One thousand nine hundred and eighty-two (1982) BETWEEN

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC ARCHBISHOP OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF WELLINGTON

a "Corporation Sole" (hereinafter with his successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part AND HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") of the second part

WHEREAS

- A The Proprietor and the Minister pursuant to Section 7 (2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 signed an integration agreement on the 5th day of November 1981 for Sacred Heart School, Guilford Terrace, WELLINGTON (hereinafter referred to as the "original Deed of Agreement")
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend Clause 8 and the Third Schedule of the original Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7 (9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT the words "one hundred and eighty-one (181) pupils" in the 5th line in Clause 8 of the original Deed of Agreement be deleted from that Agreement and the words "two hundred and thirty (230) pupils" be substituted therefor.
2. THAT the Third Schedule to the original Deed of Agreement be amended on page number 24 of that Agreement by inserting under the words "Provide the following facilities by remodelling or new construction" the words "Additional teaching space of 65m²" and "Increased staffroom area of 4.5m²". These items are to be completed by 31 March 1984.
