SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

1. THAT the words "seven hundred and twenty (720)" in the 5th line in clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement be deleted from that Agreement and the words "seven hundred and thirty-five (735)" be substituted therefor.
