SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

SACRED HEART COLLEGE, NAPIER

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 25 day of July

One thousand nine hundred and eighty four (1984) BETWEEN

THE INSTITUTE DE NOTRE DAME DES MISSIONS TRUST BOARD

a body corporate registered under the Charitable Trusts Act 1957 (hereinafter with its successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part AND HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") of the second part

WHEREAS

- A The Proprietor and the Minister pursuant to Section 7 (2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 signed an integration agreement on the 29th day of MARCH 1983 for Sacred Heart College, NAPIER (hereinafter referred to as the "original Deed of Agreement").
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend Clause 8 of the original Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7 (9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1 THAT the second sentence beginning "It is agreed ..." in Clause 8 of the original Deed of Agreement be deleted from that agreement and the sentence "It is agreed by and between the parties hereto that the maximum roll of the school shall be three hundred and sixty-five (365) pupils of whom no more than three hundred and five (305) shall be day pupils.

2 THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the said Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the said Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
