

SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

SACRED HEART GIRLS' COLLEGE, NEW PLYMOUTH

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 20th day of September two thousand and seven (2007) between the MISSION COLLEGE NEW PLYMOUTH TRUST BOARD a Body Corporate registered under the Charitable Trusts Act 1957 (hereinafter with its successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister") of the second part.

WHEREAS

- A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 6th day of February 1982 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established **Sacred Heart Girls' College, New Plymouth** as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend the Deed of Agreement pursuant to section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:


- 1.** **THAT** the Plan annexed to the Second Schedule of the Deed of Agreement be deleted and the Plan annexed hereto be substituted therefor.




