

SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT
SACRED HEART SCHOOL, REEFTON.

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 16 day of June one thousand nine hundred and eighty two (1982) BETWEEN THE ROMAN CATHOLIC ARCHBISHOP OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF WELLINGTON a "Corporation Sole" (hereinafter with his successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part AND HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") of the second part

WHEREAS

- A The Proprietor and the Minister pursuant to Section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 signed an integration agreement on the 29th day of March 1982 for Sacred Heart School, Reefton.
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend the Second Schedule to that original Deed of Agreement, pursuant to Section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT the word "blue" in the sixth line of the paragraph entitled "The School Premises" in the Second Schedule to the said integration agreement be deleted from the agreement, and the word "green" be substituted therefor.
2. THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the said Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed
