SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

SAN ANTONIO SCHOOL, EASTBOURNE

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the day of One thousand nine hundred and ninety (1996) BETWEEN THE ROMAN

CATHOLIC ARCHBISHOP OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF WELLINGTON a "Corporation Sole" (hereinafter with his successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister") of the second part

WHEREAS

- A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the Twentieth (20) day of May, One thousand, nine hundred and eighty-two (1982) as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established SAN ANTONIO SCHOOL, EASTBOURNE as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- The Proprietor and the Minister wish to vary the Deed of Agreement pursuant to section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- THAT the words "fifty five (55)" in the 5th line in Clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement be deleted from that Agreement and the words "seventy eight (78)" be substituted therefor.
- THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
