SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

SOLWAY COLLEGE MASTERTON

DATED 3rd day of July 1992

PARTIES

- (1) <u>SOLWAY COLLEGE BOARD OF GOVERNORS (INCORPORATED)</u> a society duly incorporated under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908, the proprietor of Solway College, Masterton (hereinafter together with its successors and assigns called "the Proprietor")
- (2) <u>HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN</u> acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter called "the Minister")

RECITALS

- A. The Proprietor and the Minister pursuant to Section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 signed an Integration Agreement on the 9th day of May 1978 for Solway College, Masterton (hereinafter referred to as "the original Deed of Agreement").
- B. The Proprietor and the Minister signed a Supplementary Deed of Agreement (hereinafter called "the 1990 Supplementary Deed") on the 6th day of March 1990 which amended the original Deed of Agreement.
- C. The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to further amend the original Deed of Agreement (as amended by the 1990 Supplementary Deed), pursuant to Section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT

1. THAT Clause 6 of the original Deed of Agreement (as amended by the 1990 Supplementary Deed) be deleted and the following clause be substituted:

"CLAUSE 6 IT is agreed by and between the parties hereto that:

- (a) The maximum roll of the school shall be 175 pupils.
- (b) In the 1992 year of those 175 pupils there shall be no more than 35 day pupils.

Thereafter any increase in roll shall be the subject of a Supplementary Agreement. It is further agreed by the parties hereto that the total roll for Forms 1 and 2 shall be not more than 25 pupils.

The Proprietor agrees that pursuant to paragraphs (d) and (e) of Clause 2 of this Agreement it will bring the school up to the standard of accommodation established from time to time by the Secretary of Education for a comparable State School."
