## SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

## ST BRENDAN'S SCHOOL, HERETAUNGA

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 3 | day of Mayer two thousand and eight (2008) BETWEEN THE ROMAN CATHOLIC ARCHBISHOP OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF WELLINGTON a "Corporation Sole" (hereinafter with his successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part and THE SOVEREIGN IN RIGHT OF NEW ZEALAND acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister") of the second part

## **WHEREAS**

- A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the first (1<sup>st</sup>) day of October, one thousand, nine hundred and eighty-one (1981) as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established St Brendan's School, Heretaunga as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- <u>B</u> The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend the Deed of Agreement pursuant to section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the Plan attached to the Second Schedule of the Deed of Agreement be deleted and replaced by the Plan attached hereto.
- 2. THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
