

SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT
ST. BRENDAN'S SCHOOL, HERETAUNGA

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 7 day of *August*
One thousand nine hundred and eighty-two (1982) BETWEEN
THE ROMAN CATHOLIC ARCHBISHOP OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF WELLINGTON
a "Corporation Sole" (hereinafter with his successors referred to
as "the Proprietor") of the first part AND HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN
acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter
referred to as "the Minister") of the second part

WHEREAS

- A The Proprietor and the Minister pursuant to Section 7 (2) of
the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 signed
an integration agreement on the 1st day of October 1981
for St. Brendan's School, Heretaunga.
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to
amend Clause 8 of that original Deed of Agreement pursuant to
Section 7 (9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration
Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED
AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:-

1. THAT the words "two hundred and forty (240) pupils"
in the 5th line in Clause 8 of the said integration
agreement be deleted from that agreement and the words
"two hundred and fifty-five (255) pupils"
be substituted therefor.
2. THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and
implied in the said Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed
subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other
respects the said Deed of Agreement is confirmed.


