

SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

ST CATHERINE'S COLLEGE, KILBIRNIE

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the *9th* day of *February* 1998
BETWEEN THE SISTERS OF MERCY (WELLINGTON) TRUST BOARD
(hereinafter referred to as "the Proprietor") and **HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN**
acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the
Minister").

WHEREAS

- A** Following a Deed of Agreement dated the 26th day of March 1983 as varied by subsequent agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), between the Minister and the Proprietor, the Minister pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") established **St Catherine's College, Kilbirnie, Wellington** as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- B** Pursuant to section 7(9) of Act, the Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed to change the percentage of non-preference pupils in attendance at the school as specified in clause 10(b) of the Deed of Agreement.

NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THE** Deed of Agreement is hereby amended by:
 - (a) Omitting from clause 10(b) the words "shall be limited at all times to five percent", and
 - (b) Substituting the words "shall be limited at all times to 10 percent".
2. **THAT** the covenants, conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Deed of Agreement shall be read together with clause 1 of this Supplementary Deed of Agreement but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
