BETWEEN: ST JOHN'S GIRLS' SCHOOL INCORPORATED an incorporated society registered under the Incorporated Societies Act 1908 ("the proprietor") of the first part

AND: <u>HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN</u> acting by and through the Minister of Education ("the Minister") of the second part

- A. By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 20th day of March 1990 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements ("the Deed of Agreement") the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established St John's Girls' School, Invercargill ("the School") as an integrated school.
- B. The Minister and the Proprietor wish to vary the Deed of Agreement to take account of the changes introduced to the education system consequent on the passing of the Education Act 1989 and its subsequent amendments.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY
COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE

1. THAT the words "as established by the Minister of Education" in Clause 21 of the Deed of Agreement be deleted and the words "as established pursuant to the Education

Act 1989" be substituted therefor.

2. THAT the words "with the Education Act 1964" be deleted from Clause 25 of the Deed of Agreement.

3. THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Integration Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Integration Agreement is confirmed.
