SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

ST JOSEPH'S CATHOLIC SCHOOL, WHAKATANE

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 20m day of September two thousand and seven (2007) BETWEEN THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOP OF HAMILTON a "Corporation Sole" (hereinafter with his successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister") of the second part.

WHEREAS

- A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 12th day of October 1982 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established St Joseph's Catholic School, Whakatane as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend the Deed of Agreement pursuant to section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- **1. THAT** the Plan attached to the Second Schedule of the Deed of Agreement be deleted and replaced by the Plan attached hereto.
- 2. THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
