

SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

ST JOSEPH'S SCHOOL, OAMARU

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 8th day of November One thousand nine hundred and ninety-three (1993) BETWEEN THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOP OF THE DIOCESE OF DUNEDIN a Corporation Sole (hereinafter with his successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") of the second part

WHEREAS

- A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 6th day of October 1982 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7 (2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established St Joseph's School, Oamaru, as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School")
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to redefine the School Premises as defined in the Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7 (9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

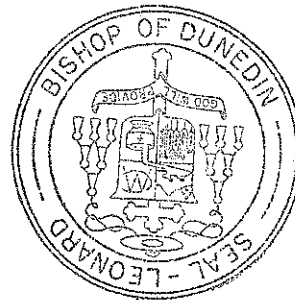
