SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

ST JOSEPH'S SCHOOL, OPUNAKE

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 13th day of September One thousand nine hundred and eighty-four (1984) BETWEEN
THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOP OF THE DIOCESE OF PALMERSTON NORTH

a "Corporation Sole" (hereinafter with his successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part AND HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") of the second part

WHEREAS

- The Proprietor and the Minister pursuant to Section 7 (2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 signed an integration agreement on the "14th day of September 1982 for St Joseph's School, OPUNAKE (hereinafter referred to as the "original Deed of Agreement").
- The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend Clause 8 of the original Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7 (9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:-

- THAT the words "one hundred and thirty-nine (139)"
 in the 4th line in Clause 8 of the original Deed of Agreement be deleted from that Agreement and the words "one hundred and fifty-four (154) pupils" be substituted therefor.
- THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the said Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the said Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
