SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 13 day of Selfmuber
One thousand nine hundred and eighty-three (1983) BETWEEN

The Proprietor and the Minister pursuant to section 7 (2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 signed an integration agreement on the 31st day of March 1983 for St Joseph's School, Otahuhu

(hereinafter referred to as the "original Deed of Agreement").

The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend Clause 8 of the original Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7
(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:-

- THAT the words "two hundred and eighty (280)"

 in the 4th line in Clause 8 of the original Deed of Agreement
 be deleted from that Agreement and the words "three hundred (300)"
 be substituted therefor.
- THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the said Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the said Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
