- By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 27th day of January 1983 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established St. Joseph's School, Pukekohe, as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend Clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY

COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES

HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the words "two hundred and eighty-five (285) pupils" in line 4 of Clause 8 be deleted, and the words "three hundred and twenty pupils" be substituted therefor.
