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SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

SAINT MARY'S SCHOOL, GISBORNE

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the *6th* day of *June*
One thousand nine hundred and eighty *eight* (1988)
BETWEEN THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOP OF THE DIOCESE OF
HAMILTON a "Corporation Sole" (hereinafter with his
successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the
first part AND HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and
through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred
to as "the Minister") of the second part

WHEREAS

A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the
26th day of January 1982 as varied by any
subsequent supplementary agreements
(hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of
Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor
pursuant to Section 7(2) of the Private
Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975
established **Saint Mary's School, Gisborne**
as an integrated school.

B The Proprietor and the Minister are now
agreed on the need to amend the Deed
of Agreement pursuant to Section 7(9)
of the Private Schools Conditional
Integration Act 1975.

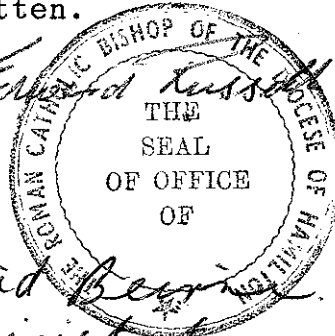
NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY
COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES
HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.** **THAT** the words "for Girls and Boys from New
Entrants to Standard Four (4)" in Recital B
on page one of the Deed of Agreement be
deleted from the agreement and the words
"for Girls and Boys from New Entrants to
Form Two (2)" be substituted therefor.
- 2.** **THAT** the words "three hundred and eighty (380)
pupils" be deleted from the 5th line in clause 8
of the Deed of Agreement and the words "two
hundred and fifty (250) pupils" be substituted
therefor.

- 3. THAT the words "nineteen (19)" be deleted from the 9th line in clause 10 (b) of the Deed of Agreement and the words "twenty-seven (27)" be substituted therefor.
- 4. THAT the words "for boys and girls from new entrants to standard four" in lines 1 and 2 of clause 23 of the Deed of Agreement be deleted from the agreement and the words "for boys and girls from new entrants to form two (2) with the form two pupils remaining on the Campion College site in 1988" be substituted therefor.
- 5. THAT the Third Schedule to the Deed of Agreement be deleted and the Schedule attached to this Supplementary Agreement be substituted therefor.
- 6. THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the said Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the said Deed of Agreement is confirmed.

THIRD SCHEDULE
