## SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 25th day of Movemone thousand nine hundred and eighty expressions.

- The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend Clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement pursuant to section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.
