SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

ST PATRICK'S SCHOOL, KILBIRNIE, WELLINGTON

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the Aday of Worker two thousand and thirteen (2013) BETWEEN THE ROMAN CATHOLIC ARCHBISHOP OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF WELLINGTON, a body Corporate registered under the Religious Charitable and Education Trusts Act 1957 (hereinafter with its successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister") of the second part.

WHEREAS

- A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 1st day of March, one thousand nine hundred and eighty-three (1983) as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established St Patrick's School, Kilbirnie, Wellington as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend Clauses B and 24 of the Deed of Agreement pursuant to section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- THAT the words "New entrants to standard four (4)" be deleted from the Integration Deed of Agreement and the words "Year 1 to 7 from Term 1 2014 and Year 1 to 8 from Term 1 2015" be substituted therefor.
- THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
