SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

ST PATRICK'S CATHOLIC SCHOOL, TAUPO

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 1st day of April one thousand nine hundred and ninety-nine (1999) BETWEEN **THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOP OF THE DIOCESE OF HAMILTON** a "Corporation Sole" (hereinafter with his successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part and **HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN** acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister") of the second part.

WHEREAS

- A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 4th day of September 1996 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") established **St Patrick's Catholic School, Taupo** as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed to amend Clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement pursuant to section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

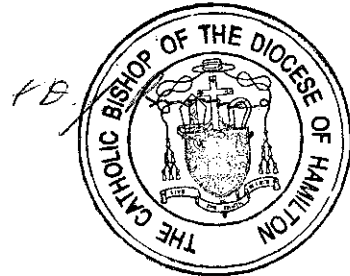
NOW THEREFORE THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

1. **THAT** the words "one hundred and fifty six (156) pupils" in the 2nd line in clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement be deleted from that Agreement and the words "one hundred and eighty two (182) pupils" be substituted therefor.
2. **THAT** the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
