SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

SAINT PETER'S COLLEGE, EPSOM

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the day of May of May of One thousand nine hundred and eighty-three (1983) BETWEEN

THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOP OF THE DIOCESE OF AUCKLAND

a "Corporation Sole" (hereinafter with his successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part AND HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") of the second part

## WHEREAS

- A The Proprietor and the Minister pursuant to Section 7 (2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 signed an integration agreement on the 26th day of January 1982 for Saint Peter's College, Epsom (hereinafter referred to as the "original Deed of Agreement").
- <u>B</u> The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend Clause 8 of the original Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7 (9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

## NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:-

- 1. THAT the words "two hundred and twenty-five (225) pupils" in the 9th line in Clause 8 of the original Deed of Agreement be deleted from that Agreement and the words "two hundred and thirty five (235) pupils" be substituted therefor.
- 2. THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the said Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the said Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
