

SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

ST. PIUS X SCHOOL, GLEN INNES

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the ^{1st} day of July
One thousand nine hundred and ninety-three (1993) BETWEEN
THE ROMAN CATHOLIC BISHOP OF THE DIOCESE OF AUCKLAND a
"Corporation Sole" (hereinafter with his successors
referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part and HER
MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of
Education (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister") of
the second part

WHEREAS

- A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 4th day of
November 1980 as varied by any subsequent
supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as
"the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the
Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private
Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established
St. Pius X School, Glen Innes, as an integrated
school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the
need to amend Clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement
pursuant to Section 7(9) of the Private Schools
Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY
COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES
HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the words "maximum roll of the School shall be
one hundred and eighty-five (185) pupils" in lines 4
and 5 of Clause 8 on page 7 be deleted, and the words
"maximum roll of the School shall be one hundred and
ninety-five (195) pupils" be substituted therefor.

2. THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
