

SUPPLEMENTARY INTEGRATION AGREEMENT

THIS DEED made this *23rd* day of *July* 1992

BETWEEN THE RUDOLF STEINER SCHOOL HASTINGS TRUST a trust incorporated under The Charitable Trusts Act 1908 (hereinafter referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part

AND HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") of the second part

WHEREAS by Deed of Agreement dated the 21st day of January 1991 (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement") the Proprietor and the Minister pursuant to Section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established the Rudolf Steiner School at Hastings as an integrated school in accordance with the Act

AND WHEREAS the Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend the Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7 of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 to provide for certain changes that have occurred since the 29th day of January 1991

NOW THEREFORE this Deed witnesseth that it is hereby covenanted agreed and declared by and between the parties hereto as follows:

That the words "three hundred and forty eight (348) pupils" in the second line in Clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement be deleted from the Agreement and the words "three hundred and eighty three (383) pupils" be substituted therefore.

THE PARTIES HEREBY CONFIRM all other covenants conditions restrictions contained or implied in the Deed of Agreement which remain unaffected as a consequence of the execution of this Supplementary Agreement herein which will remain in

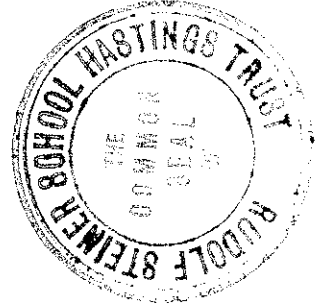
