

SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

VILLA MARIA COLLEGE, CHRISTCHURCH

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 8th day of November One thousand nine hundred and ninety-three (1993) BETWEEN THE SISTERS OF MERCY (DIOCESE OF CHRISTCHURCH) TRUST BOARD, a "Body Corporate" (hereinafter with its successors referred to as "the Proprietor") of the first part and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "the Minister") of the second part

WHEREAS

- A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 9th day of October 1981 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established Villa Maria College, Christchurch, as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend Clause 8 of the Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT the words "fifty-nine (59) pupils" in line 8 of Clause 8 on page 6 be deleted from the Agreement, and that the words "sixty-four (64) pupils" be substituted therefor.


