SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

WA ORA MONTESSORI SCHOOL, LOWER HUTT

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the two thousand and eleven (2011) BETWEEN WA ORA MONTESSORI SCHOOL INCORPORATED (the Proprietor") of the first part and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter referred to as "The Minister") of the second part.

WHEREAS

- A By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 10th day of September 1993 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as "the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established Wa Ora Montessori School, Lower Hutt as an integrated school (hereinafter referred to as "the School").
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend clause 1 and Background C of the Deed of Agreement pursuant to section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT WITNESSETH THAT IT IS HEREBY COVENANTED AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT the words "Year 1-10" be deleted from the Integration Deed of Agreement Background C and the words "Year 1-13 composite school" be substituted therefor.
- 3. THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the Deed of Agreement shall be read and construed subject to the modifications herein contained but in all other respects the Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
