SUPPLEMENTARY DEED OF AGREEMENT

WAIKATO DIOCESAN SCHOOL FOR GIRLS, HAMILTON

THIS DEED OF AGREEMENT is made on the 15th day of July one thousand nine hundred and eighty six (1986)

BETWEEN WAIKATO BOARD OF DIOCESAN SCHOOLS a body duly incorporated under the Charitable Trusts Act 1957 (hereinafter together with its successors and assigns called "the Proprietor") of the first part and HER MAJESTY THE QUEEN acting by and through the Minister of Education (hereinafter called "the Minister") of the second part

WHEREAS:

- By Deed of Agreement bearing date the 22nd day of February 1983 as varied by any subsequent supplementary agreements (hereinafter referred to as 'the Deed of Agreement"), the Minister and the Proprietor pursuant to Section 7(2) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975 established WAIKATO DIOCESAN SCHOOL FOR GIRLS, HAMILTON as an integrated school.
- B The Proprietor and the Minister are now agreed on the need to amend Clause 14 of the Deed of Agreement pursuant to Section 7(9) of the Private Schools Conditional Integration Act 1975.

NOW THIS DEED WITNESSETH AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED AND DECLARED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

- THAT Clause 14 of the Deed of Agreement be deleted and the following clause be substituted:
 - 14 IT is agreed by and between the parties hereto that the maximum roll of the school shall be 374 pupils of whom there shall be no more than 155 boarders. There shall be a maximum of 60 pupils in Forms I and II and a maximum of 314 pupils in Forms III and VII.

2 THAT the covenants conditions and restrictions contained and implied in the said Deed of Agreement is confirmed.
